January 2022

Now, confess Jesus to be Lord over various areas of your life. Bring each area under His Lordship. For example...

Jesus, You are Lord of my personal life. You are Lord of my public life. You are Lord of my family. You are Lord of my hobbies. Continue to list several more areas.
