January 2020

Let's worship Jesus... (it's always good to begin here!) As we enter into a new year, worship Jesus for the "new" things He has done us!

- He has made us a new creation (2 Cor 5:17)
- He has invited us into His new covenant. (Heb 9:15)
- He has new mercies (expression of His love) for us each morning. (Lam 3: 22-23)
- He has given us new life. (Rom 6:4)
- He has given us a new commandment to follow. (John 13:34-35)
- He has new plans for us. (Is 43:18)
- He has new wine and new wineskins for us. (Matt 9:17)
- He has new treasures for us. (Matt 13:51)
- He is preparing a new home for us in Heaven. (John 14:2-3)
- He has a new name for us. (Rev 2:17)

Let's pray for Clark County... and our Country

Each month we pray for one sphere of cultural influence (A Mountain) and/or one sphere of cultural need (A Valley).

This month, let's pray that our county and country would develop a culture where **all human life is valued**. Here are some "big prayers!" Are you ready? Pray that...

- Young people would know that their lives and all human is valuable and worthy of dignity.
- Parents, pastors, youth pastors, teachers, peers, etc. would know how to train kids to value life.
- Suicide, murder (including abortion) would become unthinkable!
- God's moral standards (that the sexual relationship is reserved for the marriage relationship) would permeate our culture.
- Every conceived child would be born and fully loved by their mom and dad.
- Adoption would always be a better option than abortion.
- Ministries assisting pregnant moms (Options 360, Pathways, etc.) would be effective and flourish.

February 2020

This month, let's pray for reconciliation, especially racial reconciliation.

Let's pray for Clark County... and our Country

Each month we pray for one sphere of cultural influence (A Mountain) and/or one sphere of cultural need (A Valley). This month, let's pray for more people to come to know and love the Savior!

There is a congregation who has just begun to systematically distribute the Gospel to all 18,000 households in the 98661 zip code. That is, generally, the southern portion of the area between I-5 and I-205. These are ordinary people with an extraordinary vision. Let's pray for them!

- Their primary request is that God would open hearts to the convicting work of His Spirit.
- Their second request is for more people to pray for this effort. (That's us!)
- Also pray for more people (from their congregation and other congregations) to engage in the process.
- Finally, pray that those who receive the message would be well established in a good, Bible-believing congregation.

Let's pray for Radiant Church

- Here is what's on Pastor Jeremy's heart in response to COVID-19
 - That fear would not infect the hearts of the congregation. But instead be full of inner strength, love and self-control
 - That God would use this circumstance to reveal to us any ways we may be treating this world as if it is all there is... instead of employing a heavenly perspective
 - That we would bring peace and calm to a concerned community. Through conversations, acts of kindness, wise social media posts
 - That we respond to the leading of the Holy Spirit and not fearful circumstance
 - That we would be wise and not cavalier in our response to COVID-19
 - That those suffering in our community from COVID-19 would recover
 - That God would protect the people of East Clark County from the spread of the disease
 - That God would give wisdom to Pastors in East Clark County on how to proceed during these unusual circumstances.

Let's pray for our Unreached People Group (There are 31 UPG's in the world with a population of more than 10 million people and less than .1% followers of Christ.) Each month we are praying for the Uyghurs in NW China.

- These people have also been impacted by COVID 19. Let's pray for them in a similar manner as we prayed for those in our country.
- Also, the Uyghur people have been very mistreated recently and this has even made international news. Pray that they would not be singled out as a minority people and be harshly treated.

Finally pray that more workers would be called to move to this area to befriend and minister the true gospel to them.

April 2020

Let's worship Jesus... (it's always good to begin here!) One of the most popular worship songs right now describes God as the "Waymaker." Let's worship Him using titles truths from this song.

Jesus, You are the **Waymaker** – Worship Him for the different "Ways" He has made for you.

Jesus, You are the **Miracle Worker** – Worship Him because of the miracles He has performed, in Scripture and in your personal life.

Jesus, You are the **Promise Keeper** – Worship Him for the Promises He has made to you and how He has kept each one of them.

Jesus, You are the **Light in the Darkness** – Worship Him because of the "light" He has shined into your darkness (both the direction He has given you and the truth He has shown you).

My God! That is Who You are! Worship Him for being the true and living God in your life!

Let's pray for Clark County... and our Country

Each month we pray for one sphere of cultural influence (A Mountain) and/or one sphere of cultural need (A Valley). This month, let's pray for our medical workers.

(This note was written toward the end of March, so, it is possible some of these requests are outdated by now. Update them as necessary as you pray.)

- 1) Give thanks to God for all those who have chosen to go into this field in order to serve others in the physical realm.
- 2) Pray that God would give medical and political people great wisdom as to how to bring COVID 19 to an end – soon.
- 3) Pray for those impacted by this virus to know God's peace and strength. That those infected would be fully restored quickly.
- 4) Pray that we would hear wonderful stories of God's protection and grace during this unusual time.
- 5) Pray that all those impacted by the downturn in the economy would not only be fully restored, but would be better off than before.

Here are some prayer points from Pastor Jeremy.

Pray that we as a congregation would be a winsome witness during quarantine.

Pray that we would be a resource of hope and calm to others.

Pray that we would share hope by being aware of the opportunities God provides us with, as well being proactive to be ready to follow the nudges of the Holy Spirit.

Pray that God would bring people into our lives whom we can pray for.

Pray that the Lord would purify us by showing us what things to put off and put on during this time.

And pray that we would continue with any good spiritual habits we have adopted during this time and let go of any bad habits we have picked up.

Let's pray for our Unreached People Group (There are 31 UPG's in the world with a population of more than 10 million people and less than .1% followers of Christ.) Each month we are praying for the Uyghur people of China.

Review: The Uyghur (Pronounced Wee-Gur) people have a Turkish ethnic background and are nearly all Muslims. Therefore, they are a distinct minority in China. There are 11.5 million Uyghurs who generally live in NW China. At this time many of them are in "Re-education Camps" with terrible conditions.

Pray that their families will increasingly be drawn to Jesus and to the message of the Bible. Pray the Lord would start a spiritual movement among them so that many experience the blessing of knowing both its story and Author. There is an estimated need of an additional 230 more workers needed to reach this people group.

May 2020

Let's worship Jesus... (it's always good to begin here. And during this time when so many things have changed, let's worship the God who never changes – for the aspects of His nature that never change. I will begin a sentence, you complete it.

Because Your love never changes...

Because You are still all powerful...

Because Your mercies are new every morning...

Because You still know the end from the beginning...

Because You are just as creative as You have ever been...

Because You are as holy now as ever...

Because Your kindness is still better than life...

Because You still grieve over sin...

Because You still want all people to know how much You love them...

Because You worthy of worship...

Because we need God to 1) hear from Heaven, 2) forgive our sins, and 3) heal our land, let's pray that God's people would...

- *And Be Gracious to You...* Worship Him, thank Him for the grace He has shown to you – the grace for salvation and for daily living.
- *The Lord Turn His Face Toward You...* He is worthy to be worshipped because of His commitment to be with us forever – to never leave us or forsake us.
- *And Give You Peace...* Worship Him because He not only has peace to give us, but He, Himself is our peace.

Give thanks to the Lord for He is unchanging, His love endures forever.
