

Points for the "Point Person" August 15-22, 2021

We are so pleased you have a heart to pray for the high schools, middle schools and students and school staff in Clark County. As you pray and lead others in prayer, please consider the following points.

- Please personally get at least 10 others to join you for your time of prayer.
- We want to be very clear that we are not protesting in any way, shape or form. We are gathering to pray blessings on the students and all those involved in the education process.
- Since schools are public property, there is no problem with gathering at the flagpole to pray, but we want to be good citizens in this process.
- Be on site about 10-15 minutes early. A couple minutes before 7:00pm (or whenever you choose to meet) gather people together at the flagpole.
- Please make use of the instructional brochures.
 - Make enough copies for each person to have one. Make your best guess and go for it.
 - Follow the suggested points of "gather, scatter, re-gather"
 - When you gather, read over the panels labeled "Why Pray for High School Students?" And at least the top part of "Why Prayer Walking?" These give context to what is taking place.
 - Also point out the "Suggested Prayer Pattern" from the brochure. We have no desire to make people pray in a certain way, but we do want to give them enough direction so they can feel like they have a meaningful time of prayer.
 - Encourage people to be sensitive to God's Spirit (who is our primary prayer leader) as they pray.
- Have people introduce themselves and mention why they are there.
- Have someone (you or someone else) snap a couple pictures and text or email them to us that evening. Also include an approximate number of people at your location. Thanks!

- As you are gathered, ask someone from the school (a student, staff person, etc.) if there are any specific places at the school where it would be especially important to pray.
- It will work best if people go out in teams of 2-3. Don't force anything, but you may need to help some groups form.
- If there is a "key person" at your school, please ask for clear directions about where it is permissible and not permissible for people to be. Then give clear instructions to the pray-ers to follow those directions. If there is not a "key person" at your school, encourage pray-ers to the various parts of the school - the parking lots, the perimeter, the entrances and exits, etc.
- When you re-gather back together, ask if anyone has anything they would like to share about their prayer time. How did God lead them to pray? Any stories? And thank them for investing an hour!
- Encourage people to continue to pray for schools...
